Woman Arrested in Oklahoma for Felony Crimes Against At-Risk Person

Pueblo, CO: Pueblo County Sheriff's Office detectives assigned to the U.S. Marshals Task Force worked with law enforcement in Norman, Oklahoma, to arrest a 39-year-old Pueblo woman who was wanted on felony charges in Pueblo County for crimes against an at-risk person.

Trisha Wilda was arrested Tuesday in Norman, Okla., after Pueblo County Sheriff's detectives learned of her whereabouts and contacted law enforcement in Norman, who took her into custody. Wilda was arrested on a warrant for theft from an at-risk person, criminal exploitation of an at-risk person, and identity theft. Wilda was booked into the Cleveland County Detention Center in Norman. She is awaiting extradition back to Pueblo.

Detectives have been investigating Wilda in connection with a fraud case involving a 96-year-old woman, for whom she was a caretaker. The victim, who is now deceased, reported fraudulent charges of up to nearly \$25,000 on several credit cards. Detectives with the Pueblo County Sheriff's Office were able to trace the charges to Wilda.

Following an extensive investigation, an arrest warrant was sought and obtained for Wilda. U.S. Marshals Task Force detectives were assigned the case on Tuesday morning (March 24) and quickly determined that Wilda was in Norman, Okla., where she was arrested without incident.
